DOWNSTATE EXPRESS 2004 SENIORS CHAMPS

The quartet name, Downstate Express, comes from the fact that its members were spread out all across southern Minnesota. The quartet was formed in 1982. In the fall of the same year, it won the Land O' Lakes District Quartet Championship on its first attempt. "Downstate" also represented its district in international competition three

times before disbanding in 1985, due largely to the 450 man-miles required for each rehearsal. After an eleven-year hiatus, the Downstate regrouped in 1996 and once again earned the honor of representing its district in international competition. Ironically, the quartet man-mileage for rehearsals was even greater than before. On January 31, 2004, Downstate Express won the championship in the International Seniors Quartet Contest in Biloxi, Mississippi.

Ed Wirtz, tenor, joined the Society at age 13 after the Four Teens sang at his New Ulm, Minn., high school in 1951. A former chorus director, with two district quartet championships, Ed has been a member of the Mankato Riverblenders since 1973. He is retired from working in international engineering sales. He and his wife, Barbara, live in Wabasha, Minn.

Bruce Odell, lead, has been quartetting in the Society continuously since he joined in 1964--in only three quartets. He lives in Winona, Minn., with his wife, Karen, and is a member of the Winona Area Barbershop Chorus, for which he is a former director. He has 20 Man of Note awards and has served as a clinician, faculty member for many Land O' Lakes schools and programs, and as coach for many choruses and quartets.

Gary Rogness, bass, has been a barbershopper since 1975. Gary lives with his wife, Ginger, in Rochester, Minn., where he is an electrical component technician. They have three children: Ryan, Laura and David. He's held numerous chapter officer positions and was recipient of the Chapter Barbershopper of the Year. He has 11 Man of Note awards.

Richard "Trep" Treptow, bari, has three district quartet championships to his credit and sang with the international champion, Happiness Emporium. Richard is the Society's current Presentation category specialist. He lives in Indianapolis, Ind., where he is a financial advisor to state and local governments.

SPOTLIGHT on: Youth In Harmony



TEACH THE CHILDREN TO SING

Detroit-Oakland Chapter is proud to participate in events under the auspices of the Barbershop Harmony Society's Youth in Harmony program.

Detroit-Oakland has underwritten the cost of two scholarships this year. Two high school students will each receive a \$400 scholarship in order to further their music education. While the scholarships are offered under the auspices of the Youth In Harmony program, the scholarships are open to any senior high music student.

This has been an ongoing program at Detroit-Oakland. Vocal music teachers at several area high schools are contacted about the scholarship program and are very responsive to it. We ask that the teachers select one or two of their outstanding students and encourage them to apply for the scholarship. The teacher, in turn, is asked to write a letter of recommendation for the student(s) selected. While these students have turned out to be college bound seniors, this is not always the case. Their musical ability, and potential, are guiding factors in nominating them. Detroit-Oakland's only requirement is that the scholarship money be used to further their musical education.

The Detroit-Oakland Chapter is proud to be able to participate in the Youth In Harmony program and to do its part to encourage music education in the schools.
