- There was also some discussion regarding whether and how to promote sing-a-longs when the chorus does singouts, or at our performances.

• Tom handed out his "11+1" report spreadsheet, showing YTD and estimated upcoming income and expenses.

John Balint, VP Marketing:

- Dates of Christmas-related performances at Greenfield Village and three area hospitals were given.
- Possible additional appearance at the Fox Run Senior Center (on March 8) has not yet been decided on.

Randy Wright brought up the need to teach chapter members some basic selling skills, so that we could improve sales of both show tickets and program ads.

Finalizing the list of people who will be attending COTS in January.

Lou Stark brought up the idea of planning a joint performance with area schools (esp. the one where the year's scholarship recipient attends).
