- Recommended that there be a dollar threshold for expenses; any expenditures over this amount would require board approval.
- Discussed distributing the budget that Tom prepared last year send it to all board members with a request for updates, and subsequent discussion and approval by the board
- Distributed FINAL numbers for the expenses & income of the show in February.
  - Now that the numbers are final, we can calculate the annual contribution to the Harmony Foundation (amount is established in the Standing Regs: 10%), which for this year is \$667.62.

Jim Kunz, VP Music

• There was no Music team meeting this month.
