- We noted that, assuming the merger with Grosse Pointe goes through, we'll want to review their repertoire music and decide which of their songs we'd like to add to the combined chorus' repertoire (and which DOC songs should be dropped).
- We discussed the possibility of putting on a dinner show, which the Grosse Pointe chapter used to do with much success
- We noted that we may want to consider implementing a Singing Valentines program next year.
