 - How many and who? Only 8 step out at any given event although membership might be twice that number.

 - Guys and Dolls is dropped. Way too complicated.
 - Members are expected to know their music when they show up
 - First rehearsal will be Wednesday, March 30 at the middle school. Geoff checking on availability. Changed to March 23 due to school closure
 - Dave Montera received a letter from the Detroit Zoo written to all Zoo Contractors which is us.
 They have new vaccination policies which are complicated. The Zoo has contracted with a service called HealthShield which will handle these records
 - Each singer individually must upload proof of vaccination or a negative COVID-19 test and take an online Health screen
 - Singer must either submit their proof of vaccination (one time it appears) OR submit a negative COVID-19 test taken within 7 days prior to arrival at each the performance
 - Each singer will have to send some kind of Text to HealthShield, take a 15 second survey and get a Text answer. That answer appears to be your permission to enter the Zoo.
 - O Sounds confusing? Yes. We haven't figured out the details. Steve will contact Shaye Beasley, the Events Coordinator, for clarification. The concern is that it states that "Each person must upload their own document through their own mobile device." Some of our guys don't even check email and don't have a 'mobile device.' Shaye's reply: Our HR team sent that out to anyone who has previously worked with us! Please do not worry about it until you are confirmed to come to the Zoo. Our protocols are every changing, so who knows if this will still be the protocol.
